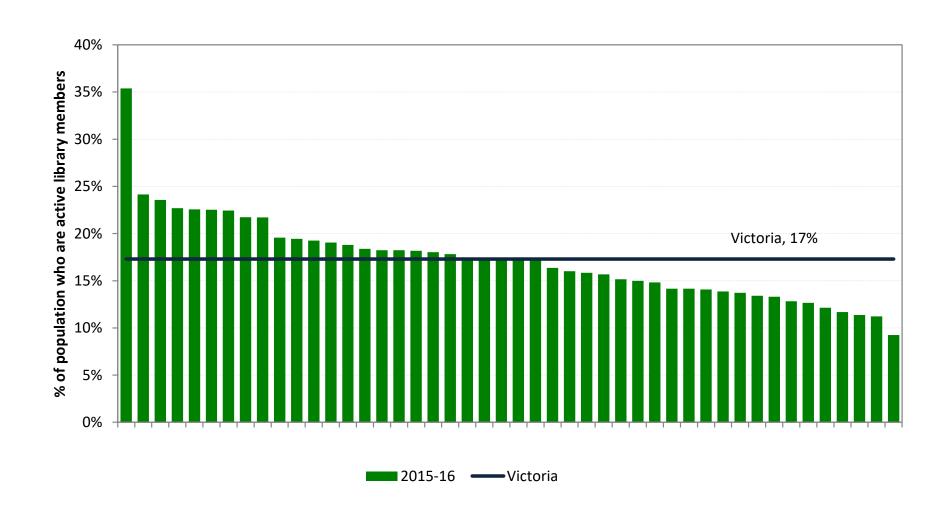

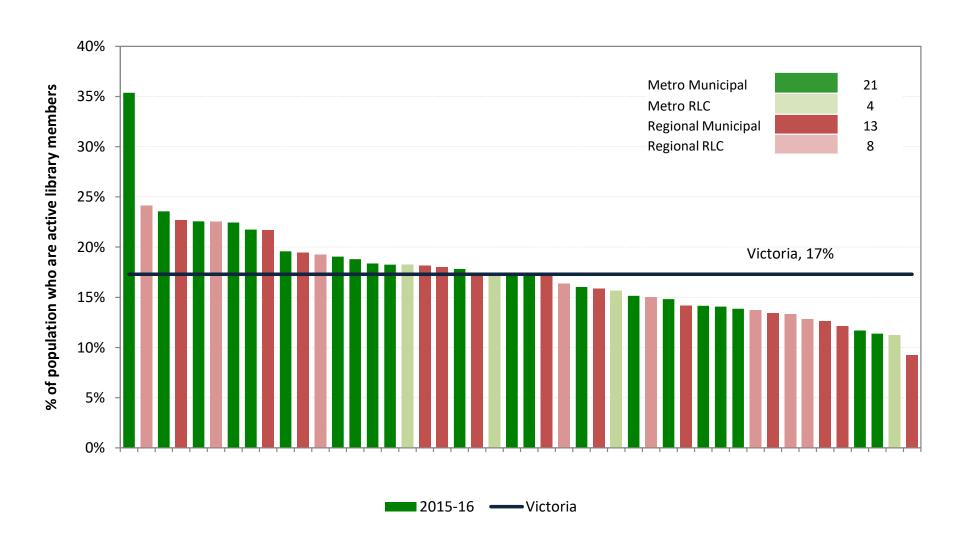

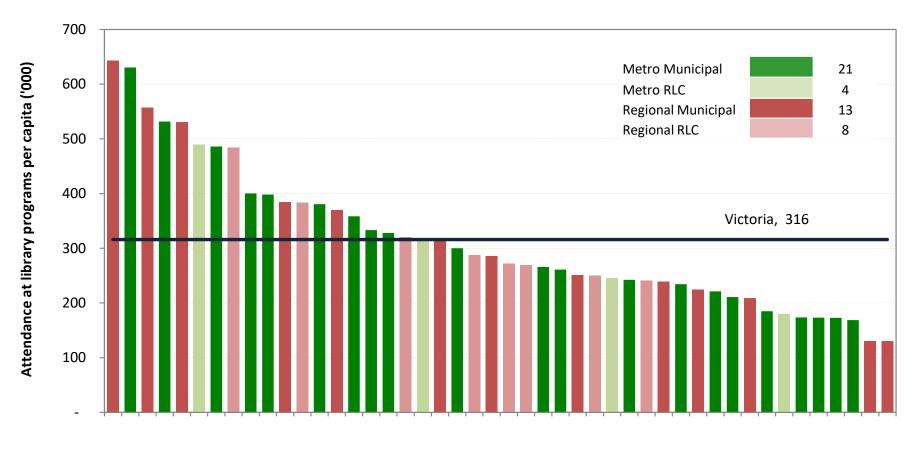

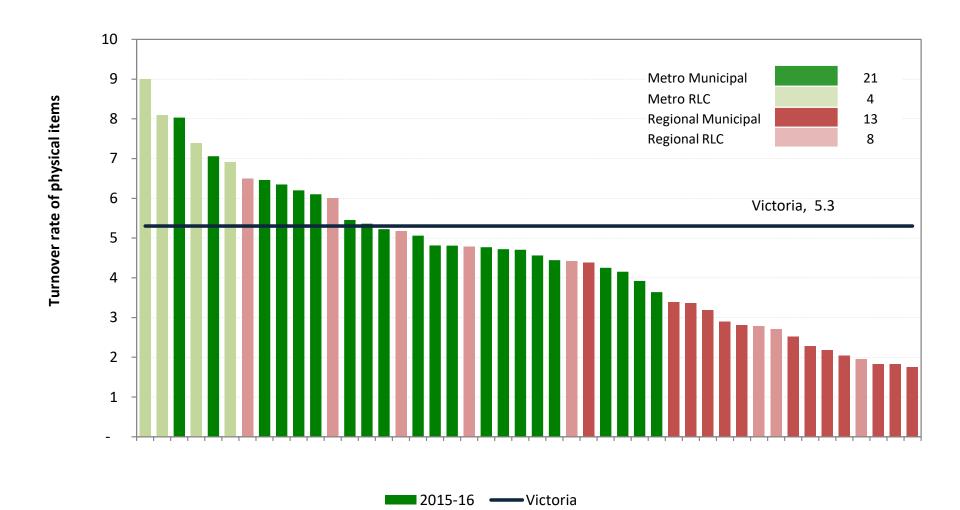


## 2. Program attendance per '000 population



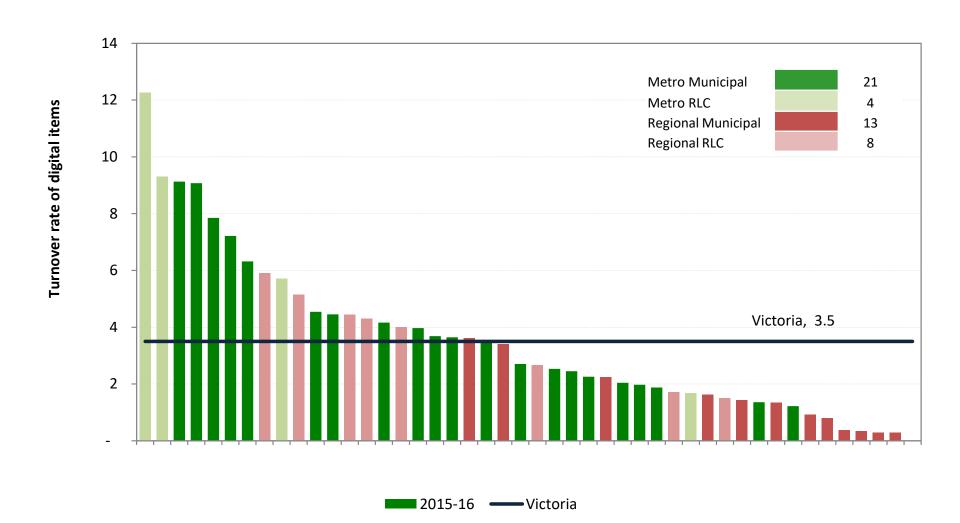


### 3. Turnover rate – Physical items



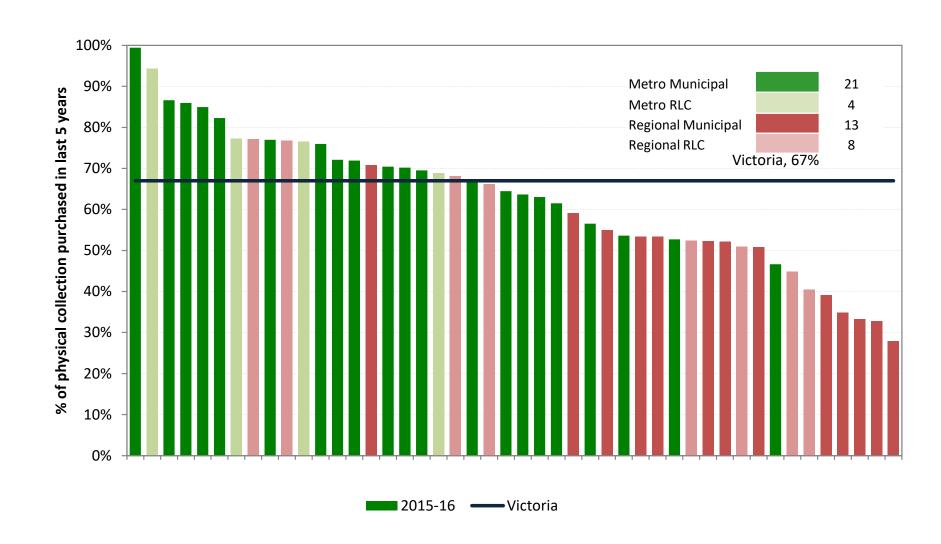

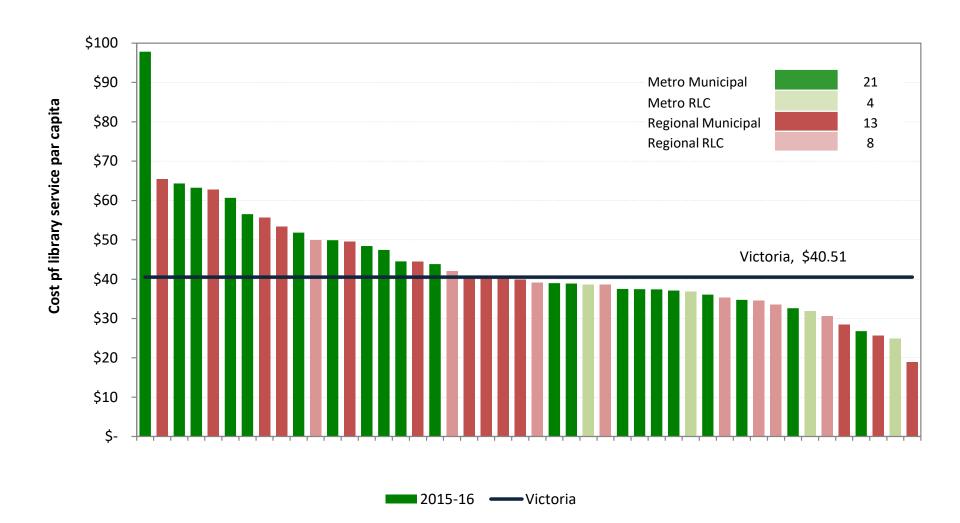




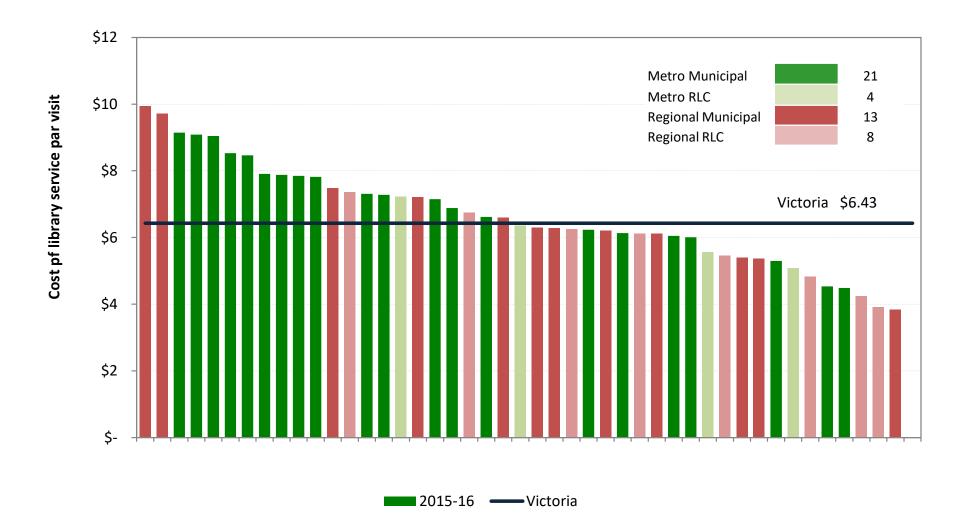
# 5. Physical quality of collection (purchased last 5 years)



#### 6. Cost per capita

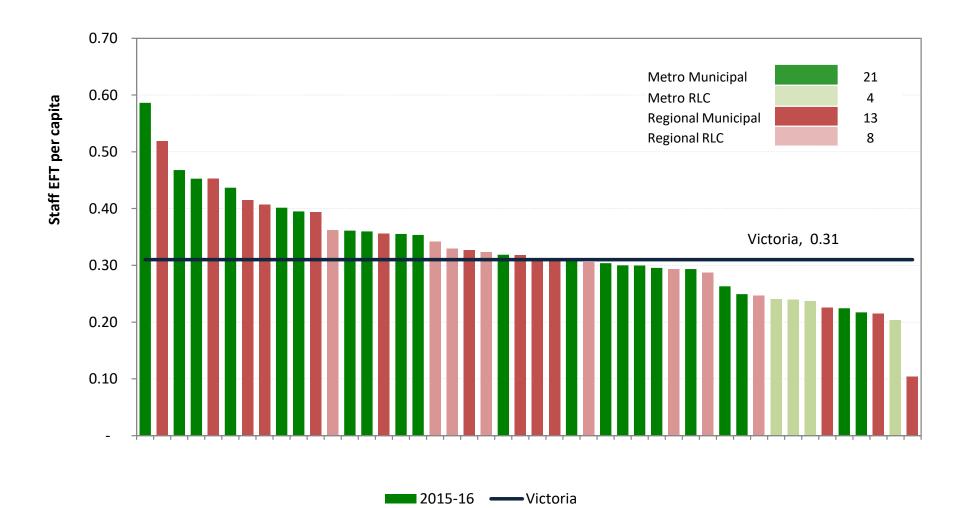

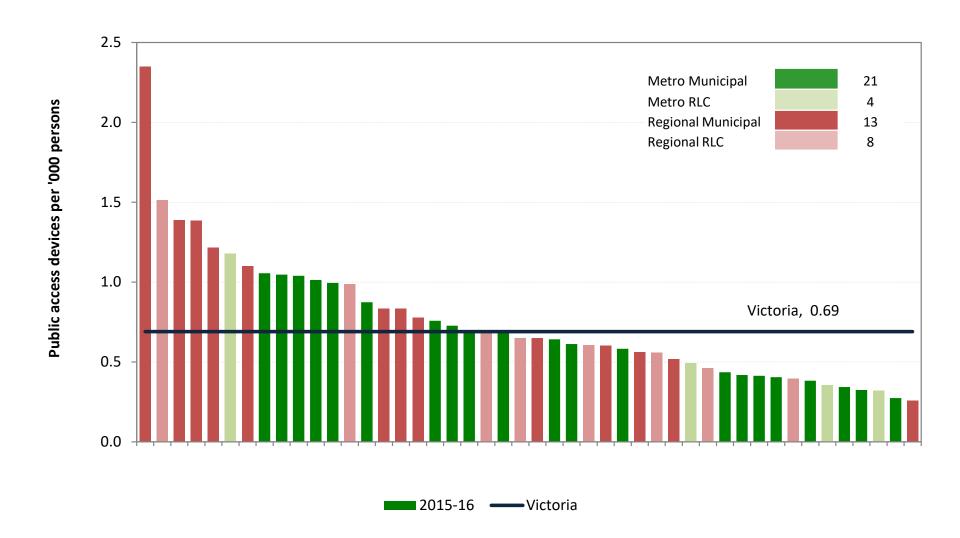

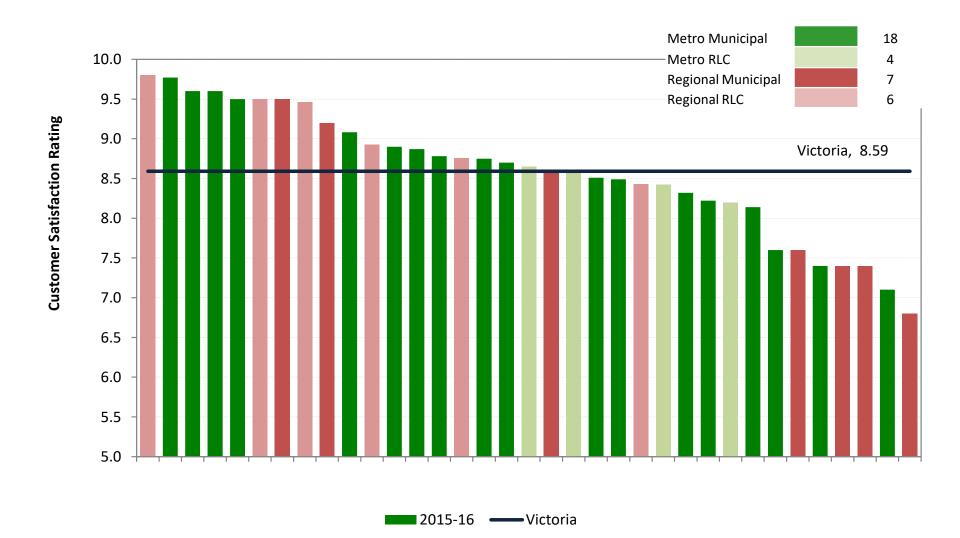

In these cases an average or mid-range figure might be seen as a desirable outcome. For presentation purposes the rankings for these indicators have the highest value ranked as No. 1 (marked #).
